In 2024, MCDL was on a roll. Sometimes literally. The Book Bike debuted in May at the Lodi Memorial Day Parade and had a full schedule at community events. It has an attached trailer, custom built by MCDL Maintenance Department staff, with enclosed shelves for books and all the technology we need.

As school let out, we were excited to begin offering Adventure Passes to the Akron Zoo, Stan Hywet Hall and Gardens, Akron Art Museum, and Brunswick Recreation Center.

Available on a first-come, first-served basis, these admission passes can be borrowed for up to a week.

This fall, along with our CLEVNET partner libraries, we launched a new online catalog and app. The fresh interface allows you to search the physical and eMedia collection simultaneously, place and manage holds, view checkouts and due dates, edit account information, and more.








