(USA Buttons Machine 250, 1.5" and 2.25")

What to bring:

- Your Artwork
 - To create your artwork, you can use...
 - Images you print or design using photo editing, graphic design, and even word processing software.
 - Use templates at https://www.americanbuttonmachines.com/pages/free-button-making-templates and other websites.
 - Online services, like https://button-designer.com/
 - Existing images from magazines, newsprint, maps, photographs, and more!
 - The paper thickness should be between 20# and 24#. Anything heavier/thicker will not seal well.
 - To make a 1.5" button, cut the paper at 1.875", but your artwork should not exceed 1.25".
 - To make a 2.25" button, cut the paper at 2.625", but your artwork should not exceed 2".

- Scissors
- Button Maker Machines
- Pin-back Circular Buttons in two sizes (1.5" and 2.25")
