2021: Rebound & Rebuild

If we thought of 2020 as a year focused on our Library's survival, 2021 was a year for rebuilding. As the pandemic rolled into a second year, we found ways to continue safely delivering services to the community while rebuilding, and in some cases reinventing, routines and practices that have become our new normal.

One primary goal in 2021 was to return to full services and hours. That meant we had to reverse our hiring pause and employ new staff to fill vacancies which were left open during the uncertainty of 2020. This means that more than 30% of our current employees are new to MCDL this year! With that influx of new talent came many new ideas and perspectives. We worked hard in 2021 to blend the old with the new and to not just rebound from the initial effects of the pandemic, but to rebuild services to the community which incorporate the best of what our library always has been, and left behind anything which was no longer optimal in a COVID world. This year saw our return to full hours and services, including passports and photos, GED testing, and community use of



the meeting and study rooms. A new Bookmobile hit the road, and we're still developing new lobby stops and pop-up library services as senior communities and daycares permit us to visit. We were able to add in-person programs, while still offering a selection of virtual and outdoor events to meet all community needs. Digital and streaming materials continue to be extremely popular, so we've been able to expand those collections while also updating our collection of physical materials.

On behalf of the library staff and trustees, I'd like to thank the community for the patience and support that you have shown for the library over the last year. There have been many changes in response to evolving community health conditions, but it continues to be our pleasure to serve the residents of Medina County. I hope to see you – in person or virtually – at the library again soon!
